ORGANISATION

1.1 NATURE OF THE EVENT

- 1.1.1 The Event shall be known as the **2022 Motorsport Australia Khanacross Championship**, herein after referred to as 'the event'.
- 1.1.2 The Event shall be conducted as a **National Khanacross** held over two days, Saturday 10th September and Sunday 11th September 2022, in line with the Event Schedule published in these Supplementary Regulations.

1.2 AUTHORITY

- 1.2.1 The Event will be conducted under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Khanacross Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations, and any Instructions to Competitors which may be issued by the Organiser and approved by Motorsport Australia.
- 1.2.2 The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia, OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au
- 1.2.3 Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au

1.3 ORGANISING PERMIT

- 1.3.1 The Permit Number authorising the event is **822/1109/04** and a copy of the permit will be posted in the Secretary's office.

1.4 PROMOTER

- 1.4.1 The Promoter and Organiser of the event will be Southern Districts Car Club Inc.

1.8 ALTERATION TO, ABANDONMENT OR TERMINATION OF THE EVENT

1.8.1 In accordance with the NCR, the Organiser reserves the right to abandon, alter, postpone, or terminate the event at any point

1.8.2 The Organiser reserves the right to stop the event at any time during competition if they consider it necessary, in the interests of safety or for any other reason

EVENT DETAILS

2.1 EVENT FORMAT

2.1.1 The event shall be conducted on unsealed surfaces at Mid Murray Motorplex 40 Staricks Road, Cambrai SA

2.1.2 The event shall consist of a minimum of six (6) tests per day, minimum of twelve tests in total over the 2 days

2.1.3 Multiple tracks will be running at the same time

2.1.4 Each track may be run in a forward and reverse direction

2.1.5 Course markers for the event may include T tyres, Candle stick, bollards

2.1.6 Electronic timing will be used to 0.01 second with a manual backup

- 2.1.7 No passengers will be allowed in vehicles while competing
- 2.1.8 At the end of competition on both days, a 30-minute parc fermé will be in effect to allow time for any protests to be lodged against that day's competition. Vehicles may be loaded onto trailers however they may not leave the venue for the duration of the parc fermé
- 2.1.9 Any drivers entered in the Australian Khanacross Championship event must compete in the same vehicle for both days of the event – subject to clause 5.2 (Replacement Vehicles) in the Motorsport Australia Khanacross Standing Regulations.
- 2.1.10 Any vehicles entered in the Australian Khanacross Championship event will not be eligible to double or triple enter in one or both of the single day Khanacross events.

2.2 Venue

- 2.2.1 The competition will be held at MMM 40 Staricks Rd Cambrai. Instructions to the complex can be found at the end of these Supplementary Regulations or by searching for "Mid Murray Motorplex" in Google Maps.
- 2.2.2 MMM is a venue consisting of a gravel surface track.
- 2.2.3 We prefer to have no animals on site. Dogs must be on a lead at all times.
- 2.2.4 Fuel is not available at MMM; however, the township of Mannum is approximately 20 minutes' drive south.
- 2.2.5 A dedicated refuelling area will be available and must be used should a driver require to refuel their vehicle
- 2.2.6 Food and refreshments will be available
- 2.2.7 Subject to entry numbers, each entered vehicle may be allocated an area in the pits. Any additional vehicles with the entry may be asked to park in the spectator parking area.

EVENT ENTRIES

3.1 ENTRIES

- 3.1.1 Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close as per the Event Schedule published in these Supplementary Regulations
- 3.1.2 There will be no entries accepted on either day, whether they be Australian Khanacross Championship or SA Khanacross Championship
- 3.1.3 The Event is open to current financial members of all Motorsport Australia affiliated car clubs
- 3.1.4 All drivers shall hold, as a minimum, a current Motorsport Australia Speed or Speed Junior competition licence
- 3.1.5 Minimum age for drivers is 14 years of age.
- 3.1.6 Entries from drivers under 18 years of age must be countersigned / consented to by a parent or legal guardian
- 3.1.7 All entries to the event are to be on the SDCC online entry form that can be found at [Click here for Online Entry System](#)
- 3.1.8 There will be a limit of seventy (70) entries
- 3.1.9 The maximum number of drivers per vehicle will be three (3)
- 3.1.10 The Organiser reserve the right to refuse entries in accordance with the NCR

- 3.1.11 The order of preference for entries will be as follows:
- Australian Khanacross Championship event – entry fee paid with application
 - SA Khanacross Championship event

3.2 ENTRY FEE

- 3.2.1 The entry fee for the Australian Khanacross Championship event will be \$200.00 for adults which includes 2 tickets to Friday night's Function and 2 tickets to Dinner at MMM on Saturday evening, and \$150.00 for juniors which includes 1 ticket for Friday night's Function and 1 ticket to Dinner at MMM on Saturday evening.
- 3.2.2 Extra meal tickets can be purchased pre-event by contacting the Secretary of the Event no later than Saturday 3rd September
- 3.2.3 Direct deposit payments are to be made to the following account:

- 3.2.4 A Driver is deemed a junior if they are not less than 14 years of age and less than 18 years of age on the first day of competition
- 3.2.5 A Competitor may claim a refund of their entry fee if the entry is withdrawn in writing before Friday 2nd September.

3.3 DRIVER BRIEFING

- 3.3.1 A driver briefing will be held at 9:15am on Saturday 10th Sept and at 8:45am on Sunday 11th September at MMM.
- 3.3.2 It is required that all drivers be present for the entire duration of the briefing and sign the drivers sign-on sheet as proof of attendance
- 3.3.3 Failure to attend the briefing will be referred to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to or including disqualification.

DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING

4.1 DOCUMENTATION

- 4.1.1 Documentation will be held at the secretary's office during the times outlined in the Event Schedule as published in these Supplementary Regulations
- 4.1.2 It is the driver's responsibility to ensure they arrive at the venue with enough time to complete documentation. Any driver who arrives late and does not complete documentation before close may not be allowed to compete.
- 4.1.3 Drivers will be required to complete self-scrutineering online at time of entry
- 4.1.4 At documentation, drivers will be required to present
 - their current Motorsport Australia competition licence (minimum Speed or Speed Junior).
 - their current Motorsport Australia competitor passbook.
 - their current Motorsport Australia affiliated club membership.
 - their vehicle's completed and signed scrutineering form.
 - Self Scrutiny Form.

4.2 SCRUTINEERING

- 4.2.1 Self Scrutineering forms must be completed online when entering.
- 4.2.2 All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4K of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 4.2.3 All vehicles must be adequately muffled to not exceed a noise limit of 95dB(A) and have fitted securely, a fire extinguisher of at least 900g capacity and complying with Technical Appendix - Schedule H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 4.2.4 Any production ATVs must be fitted with a driver's side window net.
- 4.2.5 If a vehicle has been issued a Logbook from Motorsport Australia, this must be presented to the Chief Scrutineer.
- 4.2.6 The Chief Scrutineer shall rule on the acceptability of any vehicle to compete in the event and the class in which it shall compete.

4.3 TYRE RESTRICTIONS

- 4.3.1 The tyres chosen for the event shall be listed on the Self Scrutineering form.
- 4.3.2 Any competitor found competing on tyres other than those marked for that vehicle shall be referred to the Stewards who may impose a penalty of 1 minute for each breach which will be added to the overall time for that competitor.
- 4.3.3 Any car running Rally tyres will be classified in the MP 4WD Class and MP 2 WD/Class.

4.4 HELMETS AND APPAREL

- 4.4.1 Helmets in compliance with the requirements for a Khanacross in Technical Appendix - Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are mandatory for all drivers.
- 4.4.2 All apparel worn by drivers must be of a non-flammable material and comply with the requirements for a Khanacross in Technical Appendix - Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 4.4.3 All drivers must wear an approved safety harness or seatbelt during competition in compliance with the requirements for a Khanacross in Technical Appendix - Schedule I of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

4.4.4 All drivers of open vehicles, or vehicles that have had the windscreen removed, must wear eye protection (goggles or a visor) in compliance with the requirements for a Khanacross in Technical Appendix - Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Goggles with glass lenses, whether laminated or not, are unacceptable.

4.5 CLASSES

- 4.5.1 Competition classes will be:
- Class A - Up to 1300cc
 - Class B - 1301cc to 1600cc
 - Class C - 1601cc to 2000cc
 - Class D - 2001cc to 3000cc
 - Class E - Over 3000cc
 - Class F - 2WD Specials
 - Class G - 4WD Production Vehicles
 - Class H - SxS vehicles
 - Class MP 2WD - Modified 2WD
 - Class MP 4WD - Modified 4WD

Note: Classes A to E inclusive are for 2WD Production Vehicles complying with Group 4K.

Note: Vehicles classified as specials in Group 4K must not have more than two driven wheels or more than two steered wheels

4.6 CATEGORIES

4.6.1 Competition categories will be

- 4.6.1.1 Category J - Juniors
- 4.6.1.2 Category L - Ladies

Note: Nomination in a category does not preclude a driver from competing for class awards. Competitors have the option to “opt out” of Category L if they wish.

PENALTIES AND PROTESTS

5.1 JUDGES OF FACT

5.1.1 In accordance with the NCR the following officials are deemed to be Judges of Fact

5.1.2

- Clerk of Course Darryl Power, Deputy Clerke of Course Andrew Admiraal and Assistant Clerke of Course Daniel Claridge are deemed Judges of Fact in regard to the correct application of penalties as set out in Section 5.2 (Penalties) of these Supplementary Regulations and the Motorsport Australia Khanacross Standing Regulations including:
 - not wearing seat belt / safety harness, helmet, or safety clothing
 - hitting or bypassing, T tyres, candle stick bollards
 - short cutting the course
 - driver conduct
- scrutineersTBA are deemed Judges of Fact of the following :
 - vehicle in un-roadworthy condition
 - vehicle with accident damage
 - eligibility of vehicles
 - vehicle safety equipment
 - driver apparel
- Daniel Claridge medical officer is deemed Judges of Fact of the medical condition of any crew member or team member

- timekeepers Ron Blakemore are deemed Judges of Fact in regard to correctness and accuracy of recorded times

5.2 PENALTIES

5.2.1 The following penalties will apply during the event as per the Motorsport Australia Khanacross Standing Regulation

- striking a course marker or flag (including garage boundary flag)
 - *plus five (5) seconds per marker or flag*
- failing to stop completely at the finish of a course
 - *slowest time plus five (5) seconds*
- finishing a course with the car stopped but completely outside the garage
 - *slowest time plus five (5) seconds*
- reversing after crossing the designated finish line
 - *slowest time plus five (5) seconds*
- failing to complete a test
 - *slowest time plus five (5) seconds*
- wrong direction or any procedure other than that specified as the correct procedure for completing that course
 - *slowest time plus five (5) seconds*
- finishing a course with part of the car outside the garage boundaries
 - *plus five (5) seconds and plus five (5) seconds per marker or flag*
- failure to attempt a test
 - *slowest time plus ten (10) seconds*

Note: When the slowest time plus five (5) seconds exceeds double the fastest time, the time to be applied shall be double the fastest time

Note: When establishing either fastest time or slowest time, no time which includes any penalty shall be used

5.3 DRIVER CONDUCT

5.3.1 Any driver acting in an irresponsible way may be disqualified from the event and their vehicle may not be allowed to continue in the competition, meaning any other driver entered in the vehicle may also be disqualified and will be reported to the Event Stewards who may decide to impose additional penalties.

5.3.2 Prohibited behaviour includes excessive speed in any non-competition areas, any abuse, physical or verbal, towards any official, or not obeying a reasonable direction from an official.

5.4 PROTESTS

5.4.1 All protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

5.5 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

5.5.1 The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

AWARDS

7.1 AWARDS

7.1.1 A presentation shall be held in the Telstra building as per the Event Schedule published in these Supplementary Regulations where the awards or trophies outlined below will be presented

Australian Khanacross Championship event

- 1st to 6th Outright - Trophies
- 1st in each class - Trophies
- 1st Junior - Trophy
- 1st Lady - Trophy

7.1.2 The Organiser reserves the right to add to these awards

GENERAL INFORMATION

8.1 General Information

8.1.1 Camping will be available at the Venue along with toilets and but no shower facilities. Any competitor intending to camp onsite, stay in a caravan or motorhome must pre-book with the organisers at the close of entries.

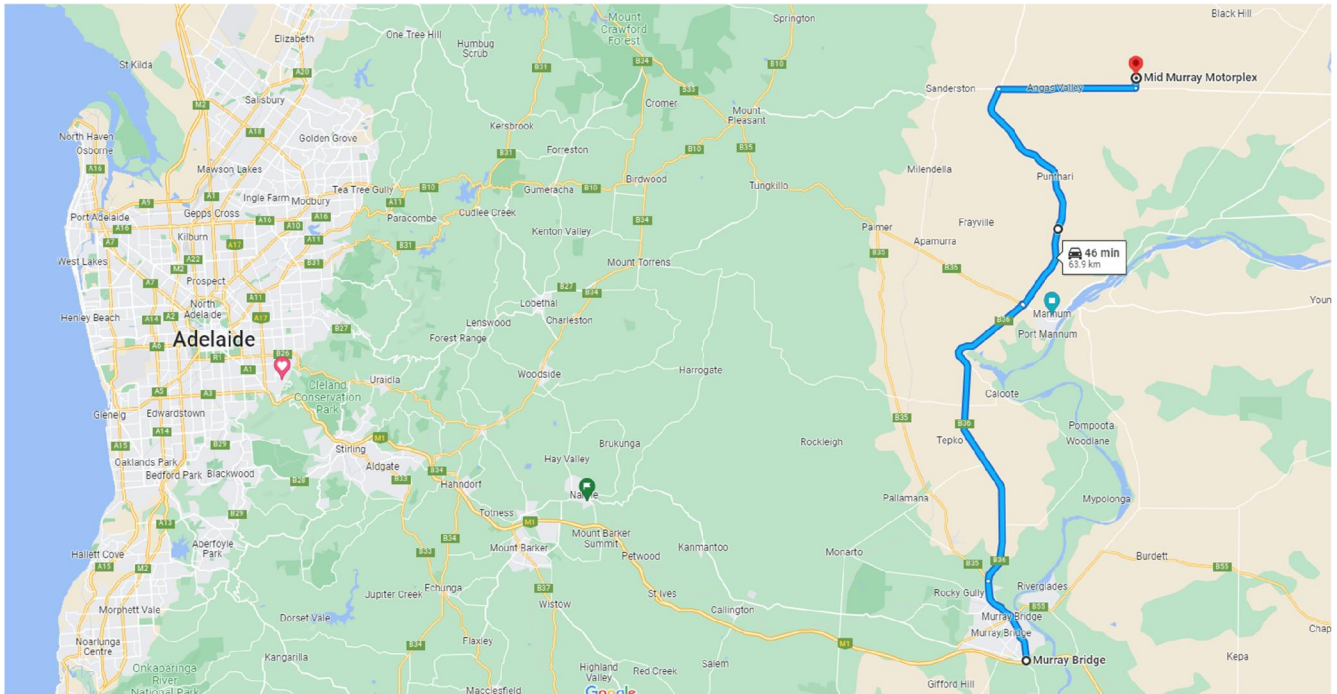
8.1.2 Food and drinks will be available for the duration of the event.
