1. NAME OF EVENT: SDCC Club Khanacross
Rd 4 of SDCC Club Championship

2. TYPE OF EVENT: Club Khanacross

3. AUTHORITY: Held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR), the Khanacross Regulations, The Motorsport Australia Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, Bulletins or Instructions issued by the Organisers.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.

6. ELIGIBILITY: The EVENT will be a **Club Khanacross** and is open to members of all Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Clubs.

7. PERMIT: The Event will be conducted under Motorsport Australia Organizing Permit No **522/1906/02** which will be displayed on the Official Notice Board at the Event. Licenced Drivers, and all Officials must be signed on.

Note: All sign on must be done electronically prior to the event.

NOTE: A Lunch Break may be called at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course

9. VENUE: Mid Murray Motorplex - Corner of Starick Road (some GPS may have Starics) and Angas Valley Road Cambrai. Approximately 10km East of Ridley Road on the Angas Valley Road. GPS S34 45.231 E139 22.641

10. TYPE OF SURFACE: Dirt

11. LICENCES: A minimum of a Speed or Speed Junior Licence is required. Introductory License (Come and Try) will be available on the day.

This Event can be used as an Observed Licence Test for the National Rally Licence

12. NUMBER OF TESTS: There will be a minimum of four tests as per the Motorsport Australia Khanacross Regulations.

13. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS: Maximum number of competitors will be 60. Should 60 entries be reached a reserve entry can be made on the website. Southern Districts Car Club reserves a maximum of 4 entries for suitably qualified SDCC Junior Development Program students.

14. MAXIMUM ENTRIES PER VEHICLE: Maximum number of Drivers per vehicle will be 4. Note: Wipes should be used between changing drivers. Under no circumstances should Helmets or Apparel be shared.

15. ENTRIES: Entries open at 2000 hrs on Tuesday 7th June, 2022

All entries must be made with all relevant details correctly filled out. Note: Entries will not be complete until

16. RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY: The Organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason. Refer also to the NCR of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

17. CLASSES and Categories:

CLASSES

- A – Production Vehicle 0 – 1500cc
- B – Production Vehicle 1501 – 2000cc
- C – Production Vehicle 2001 – 3000cc
- D – Production Vehicle over - 3000cc
- E – Production Vehicle Rear Wheel Drive any capacity
- F – 4 WD & AWD Production Vehicle
- AM – MODIFIED Production Vehicle or RALLY TYRES 0 – 1500cc
- BM – MODIFIED Production Vehicle or RALLY TYRES 1501 – 2000cc
- CM – MODIFIED Production Vehicle or RALLY TYRES 2001 – 3000cc
- DM – MODIFIED Production Vehicle or RALLY TYRES over - 3000cc
- EM - MODIFIED Production Vehicle or RALLY TYRES Rear Wheel Drive any capacity
- FM – MODIFIED 4WD & AWD Production Vehicle
- S – 2WD Specials

NOTE:- A Rear wheel drive vehicle must be nominated in **EITHER** appropriate engine capacity class **OR** Rear wheel drive class, it **cannot be in both**.

CATEGORIES

- J – JUNIORS under 16 years
- J16 – JUNIORS 16 to 18 years
- L – LADIES (Ladies must be selected on the on-line entry form)

Clarification of classes is as per attached document of these Supplementary Regulations which will also be on display at the EVENT on the Notice Board.

18. COMPETITORS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE must be counter-signed or consented to by a Parent or Guardian. No Driver shall be under the age of 12 years.

19. COMPETITORS between 12 and 13 years of age must be accompanied by an experienced Instructor as approved by the Clerk of the Course.

20. SCRUTINY AND DOCUMENTATION, ON-LINE ONLY: The following documents must be presented at ON-LINE ENTRY

- Current Motorsport Australia Competition Licence.
- Current Motorsport Australia affiliated car club membership card.
- Current Motorsport Australia Log Book (If one has been issued).

All vehicles shall comply with Schedule A and Group 4K of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

21. APPAREL

1. A minimum of a lap sash must be worn correctly at all times of competition complying with Schedule I of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
2. All Drivers (and passengers approved by the Clerk of Course) must wear approved footwear whilst competing. Refer Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
3. Approved helmet with visor or goggles must be worn and in closed cars which have the windscreen removed. Refer Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
4. For occupants in all vehicles minimum clothing is "Neck to ankle to wrist" covering. Refer Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

22. VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS:

23. REFUELLING: Vehicles may only be refuelled in the designated area. It is the Competitor's responsibility to ensure an allocated Official is present, and a functional fire extinguisher provided by the Event is in place whilst refueling any vehicle. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

24. METHOD OF TIMING: Will be either electronic timing to the 1/100th second or a manual timing system. Timing shall commence when the leading point of the car crosses the designated start line and shall cease when the leading point of the car crosses the designated finish line. The designated finish line shall not be more than one metre behind the front of the finish garage. If timing should fail to record a Competitor's time, then the Competitor shall be offered a re-run.

25. FLAGS / LIGHTS TO BE USED

Orange – Used to indicate to the driver that the competing vehicle is in the correct starting position.

Green – May be used to indicate that the timers are ready for you to start your run. This also has a Beeper when Green.

Red – indicates a situation has occurred (a danger on the course or a timing failure) which requires the Driver to cease their run. Any Driver who has been shown the red flag must immediately slow to a safe speed and proceed carefully to the next flag point for instructions from the Officials. Also **RED** will be shown as you arrive at the Garage for your run, this will change to **Orange** when you have staged.

Chequered – signals completion of the run

26. PENALTIES:

Handicap System applicable for SDCC Series rounds

Any vehicle fitted with tyres that would see them qualify for the Modified class

- Rally tyres
- Tyres marked 'not for highway use' or 'for competition use only'
- AT & MT type •
- Tyres of an aggressive nature (as determined by the chief scrutineer)
- 'Mud & snow' or
- • Tyres that have undergone tread modification

Will see them attract a handicap to their event Total elapsed (non-Penalty) time.

- Any 2WD vehicles with the above types of tyres will attract a 2% handicap (penalty)
- 4WD vehicles that qualify for class F will attract a 3% handicap (ie road tyres)
- 4WD vehicles that qualify for class FM will attract a 5% handicap (with or without rally tyres)

The handicap value applied will be the penalty time of the fastest in that group (not each individual's time)

Penalties will be added as per Khanacross Regulations of the current Motorsport Australia Manual. A penalty of EXCLUSION may also be imposed by the Stewards of the Event for Infringements as prescribed by the current NCR.

All "slowest time plus X seconds" penalties will be based on the time of the slowest non junior competitor

27. JUDGES of FACT: All Officials shall be deemed to be Judges of Fact. This includes determining whether a course or test has been correctly completed, a garage correctly entered, a field garage correctly traversed or the accuracy in timing a Competitor's run. Further duties may be defined at the COMPETITORS BRIEFING as necessary.

28. RESULTS: The winner will be the Competitor that accumulates the least amount of time penalties, including time penalties for cone or garage Infringements.

29. PROTESTS: Must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

30. AWARDS: Trophies maybe awarded to 1st Outright and Class Awards if more than 3 Drivers in each class. There will be a trophy presentation at the completion of the event.

31. CANCELLATION OF EVENT: Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with the NCR of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

32 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES: The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

33. CATERING: Food and drinks will be available. Observe social distancing as per notices and markings. Hand sanitizer available in the canteen area.

34. SPECTATORS: There may be limits on spectator numbers on the day to ensure we do not exceed the maximum allowed under SA COVID-19 Restrictions.

35. GENERAL: We no longer require a COVID-Safe Plan however all attendees are reminded of the following. Stay at home if you have any cold or flu symptoms. Maintain Social Distancing, at least 1.5 metres. Do not gather in groups. Wash your hands frequently. There will be sanitizer and hand washing facilities provided. If you develop any of the following symptoms during the day, fever, shortness of breath, sore throat, fatigue or lack of sense of smell please advise the Event Secretary

36. VENUE RULES: Southern Districts Car Club requests that dogs must be **CONTROLLED AND ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES** whilst on the property. **NO ALCOHOL** is to be consumed during the event. **No fires** are to be lit on any part of the property. Defined areas may be allocated for trailer parking, spectator parking and only competition vehicles may enter the pit area or access other roads / tracks. All vehicles are to enter competition surface under the direction of officials. All rubbish must be disposed of correctly, either in any allocated bins, or taken with you.

37. PIT Area: There will be an allocated pit area for each competition vehicle.

38. CAMPING: Camping is available in the camping area only. Bookings must be made with the Event Secretary - Free for SDCC Club members.
